




Cataloging the Ancient Near East



Cataloging the Ancient Near East





Museum Collection

Museum Conservation


Specialized training provides conservators with the knowledge to care for our collections. This includes conserving unstable objects, preparing them for display and monitoring their environment.

Integrated Database Project: Summary

- 1. Sustainable platform for data stewardship
- 2. Integrated bibliographic and object data searching, sorting, and browsing
- 3. Migration of further data silos and integration between bibliographic, object, conservation, archival, photographic, and GIS data
- 4. Expanded data entry to include archaeological field data, author's biographical data, links between volumes and volume reviews (and vice versa), and further thesaurus refinement for integration between silos
