Alice Mouton

From January 2003 until December 2003 **Alice Mouton** has been working as a Research Associate for the Chicago Hittite Dictionary Project. She is financed by the Lavoisier Grant provided by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Mouton has written several articles for the Hittite Dictionary, primarily on words starting with *ta-*. She has also transcribed the Hittite texts from Kuşaklı (Hittite city of Šarišša) for the Chicago Hittite Dictionary Project files.

On a private note, Alice Mouton has finished and submitted her dissertation and expects the defense of her Ph.D. to take place in Paris (École Pratique des Hautes Études) and Leiden University in the near future. She also took part in a congress on Anatolian Religion in Bonn in February 2003 and wrote two articles, which will be published in *Zeitschrift für Assyriologie* and *Journal of Ancient Near Eastern Religion*.
