

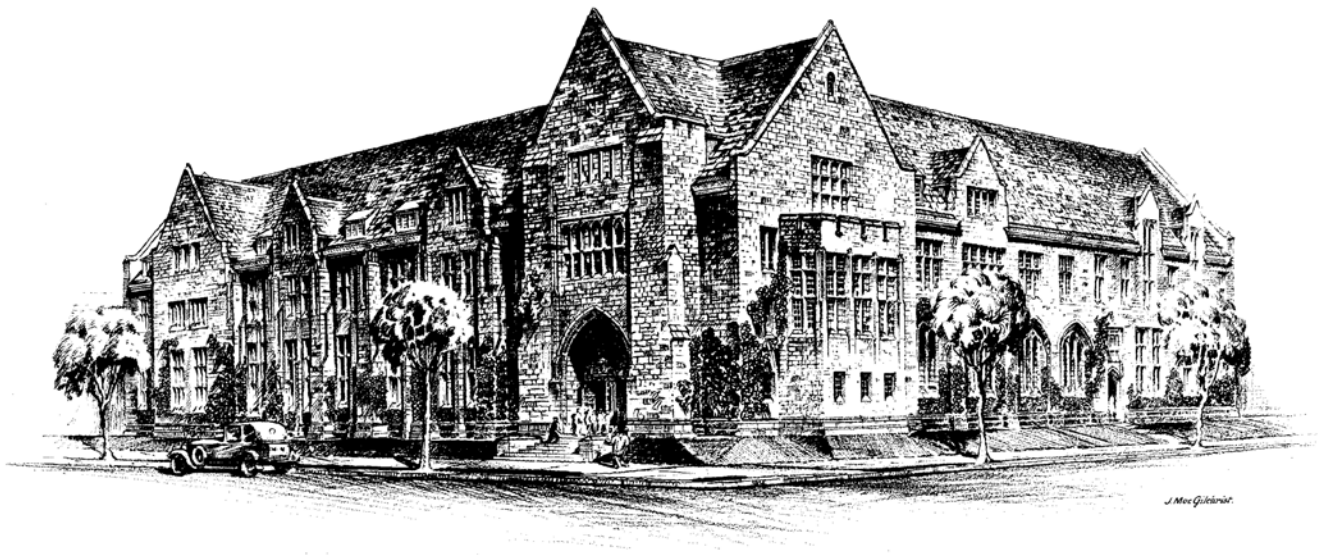

Publication of this volume commemorates the online distribution of all titles published by the Oriental Institute since its beginnings. All volumes are distributed online as Adobe Portable Document Format files (PDFs) and are available for complimentary download. Printed copies may be purchased, and the reader is advised to follow the link given for each title to learn its availability.

The book scanning project began on October 27, 2004, with a unanimous vote from the faculty of the Oriental Institute, under the direction of Director Gil J. Stein. The project concluded October 1, 2013 — nine years later, which included the scanning of about 500 publications, conversion to PDFs, creating metadata and web pages, and uploading the files to the Internet.
