In early June, the Committee hosted a fund-raising dinner for the Museum to mark the opening of the remodelled Mesopotamian Gallery. Various members of the Committee have helped in raising matching funds (\$160,540) for the National Endowment for the Humanities' grant to the Assyrian Dictionary project and in organizing the popular "Tutankhamun Revisited" lecture series at the Institute beginning August 16, 1977.
