

EDWARD WENTE's chapter on the 'genealogies of the New Kingdom royal families for James Harris's *X-ray Atlas of the Royal Mummies* is complete. He continues to work at estimating the ages at which his subjects died, using the textual and representational evidence quite apart from the pathological evidence of the mummies. His well-known Queen Tiye findings complement his edition of the texts from the tomb of her steward Kheruef, prepared for his work with the Epigraphic Survey.
