

## Individual Research Activities—1983–84

ROBERT BIGGS has continued his work on cuneiform texts of the third millennium B.C., but chose a quite different area for the paper he read in July at the international Assyriological congress in Leningrad: the relationship between Babylonian astrology and the Babylonian prophecy texts. Among his scholarly but non-Assyriological activities, was editing a volume Discoveries from Kurdish Looms, the catalogue for an exhibition of Kurdish weavings held at the Block Gallery at Northwestern University which was cosponsored by the Chicago Rug Society, of which he is a member.
