John A. Brinkman wrote several short articles dealing with aspects of the history of Babylonia in the late second millennium BC, including the entry Nebuchadnezzar I (1125–1104 BC) for the *Reallexikon der Assyriologie* and notes on the bilingual Kassite-Babylonian vocabulary BM 93005 for *NABU*. He also wrote thirty-one biographical entries for the first volume of the prosopography series of the State Archives of Assyria Project, Helsinki; and Daniel Nevez and Shelley Luppert-Barnard, graduate students in the Mesopotamian historiography seminar, wrote an additional sixteen entries. The prosopography volume was published on 1 July 1998.
