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## PREFACE

### General Remarks

This volume contains all the unpublished Sargonic material in the Louvre Museum, with the exception of the Sargonic texts derived from the excavations of Lagash and Susa.

The texts were transliterated by me mainly in the summers of 1950 and 1960. I had occasion to collate some difficult readings in 1965 and 1966.

Of the one hundred and seventy texts here published, fifty-eight texts are reproduced in photographs in the twenty-five plates at the end of the volume. Because of their importance, all the twenty-one witnessed texts, mainly purchase contracts, are given in photographic reproduction; for other groups and sub-groups of texts selected specimens are offered to enable scholars to get the feel of the schools of writing in different areas and periods. The tablets are reproduced in their original size.

The great majority of the Akkadian lexical and grammatical items found in the texts of this volume have been utilized in the past editions of my MAD II and III under the Louvre AO entries. The additional items have been entered in the new editions of MAD II and III, which are being prepared for publication.

All the citations and crossreferences in this volume, especially in the Indices, are by the Louvre AO numbers, not by numbers of texts in this volume.

This was done in order to facilitate the finding of corresponding occurrences in the MAD II and III volumes. Citing by the AO numbers should cause no difficulties since the sequence of the texts in this volume corresponds rigidly to the sequence of the AO numbers.

I wish to express my heartfelt gratitude to Messrs. Jean Nougayrol, André Parrot, and Pierre Amiet for placing the texts at my disposal and generally for making my work in the Louvre both pleasant and profitable. I am grateful also to Mr. Maurice Lambert for collating several difficult occurrences in 1965, and to Mr. Miguel Civil for contributing a number of valid suggestions in the interpretation of the texts. I am happy to acknowledge Mr. Lambert's help in supervising the production of the photographs.

Provenience and Date of Tablets

All the texts in this volume have been acquired piecemeal through the years by the Louvre Museum; none come from controlled excavations.

All the known information about the accession of the texts, as noted at the beginning of each text in this volume, was copied from the Louvre catalogues.

With the exception of texts Nos. 2-9 (AO 8636-8643), which are marked in the main Louvre catalogue as "de Tell Asmar?", nothing is known about the provenience of any of the texts here published. The evidence that these eight texts actually come from the Diyala River area is provided under No. 2 (AO 8636).

I can add no further information concerning the provenience of the texts No. 1 (AO 7983), 10-12 (AO 8959, 8960, 8961), and 13 (AO 10330).

The main question is the provenience of two texts, Nos. 14-15 (AO 11130, 11131), acquired by the Louvre Museum in 1927, and of one hundred and fifty-five texts, Nos. 16-170 (AO 11254-11413), acquired in 1929. The latter collection actually includes one-hundred and sixty texts, of which AO 11276 has been published previously by J. Nougayrol, "Conjuration ancienne contre Samana," AOr XVII/2 (1949) 213-226 and plates III-IV, while AO 11393, 11401, 11407, and 11408 have been excluded here because they are from the Ur III period.

A superficial glance at the major group of texts published in this volume immediately will bring to mind parallel texts published earlier in Nikolski, Dok. II Nos. 1-89, Hackman, BIN VIII passim, Donald in MCS IX, and in many scattered places. In addition, I have transliterated about two hundred texts of the same types in the Yale Babylonian Collection, Iraq Museum, and in the private possession of Dr. H. Serota of Chicago.

Scholars who have commented on these texts have taken for granted that they come from Umma. Thus Nikolski, Dok. II pp. 3f., Thureau-Dangin in RA VIII (1911) p. 154, Stephens in Hackman, BIN VIII p. 7, Sollberger in BO XVI (1959) pp. 114f., and M. Lambert in RA LIX (1965) p. 61; the last three in comments to the BIN VIII texts.

There is much confusion about the dating of this large and incongruous group of texts, and scholars often date texts from the classical Sargonic and even late Sargonic periods to the Pre-Sargonic period. Actually, three different chronological subdivisions should be distinguished within this group of texts, namely Pre-Sargonic, classical Sargonic, and late Sargonic.

To the Pre-Sargonic period belong texts dated to Lugalzagesi, ensi of Umma (and later king of Uruk), such as BIN VIII 26, 82, and 86, and all other texts related to them by prosopography, epigraphy, and other considerations. These texts certainly come from Umma. No texts in this volume belong to the Pre-Sargonic period.

To the classical Sargonic period belong texts dated to Naram-Sin and Šar-kali-šarri and all other texts related to them by prosopography, epigraphy, and other considerations. This period is represented by many texts in BIN VIII and this volume. The assignment of these texts to Umma has been frequently taken for granted, but never documented.

To the time after Šar-kali-šarri, or to the so-called Gutian period, belong the mu-iti texts and parallels, many of which are found in this volume. Their Umma origin is assured.

The following texts contain materials important for the dating and provenience of the texts published in this volume and related texts from elsewhere:

The entries listed above under a) to p) are presented again in the chart on page xiii. The order of the entries both in the list and the chart is approximately chronological.

The entries in the chart are grouped under three headings. The "Central Government" represents the kings of Akkad and Gutium, "Provincial Administration" represents the governors of the provinces, and "IN<sup>KI</sup>" stands for the sangas of IN<sup>KI</sup>.

Outside of the texts listed under a) to p), the site IN<sup>KI</sup> appears in the texts from Nippur (TMH V 49:5 and 88 ii 1) and of unknown provenience (BIN VIII 67:11, 31 and 125:7). Cf. also Ur-dingir-ra-na? sanga IN<sup>KI</sup> on a Sargonic seal of unknown origin (OIP XXII 96), and the personal names IN<sup>KI</sup>-dug or IN-ki-dug (A 25412, Pre-Sargonic, and PBS IX 50, Sargonic) and Lú-IN<sup>KI</sup> (Sumer XV p. 23 No. 3 and Pls. I-II). The site of IN<sup>KI</sup>, the reading and location of which are unknown, ceases to exist after the Sargonic period. The site may have been famous for its sanctuary, as there is an obvious connection between the sangas of IN<sup>KI</sup> and the provincial governors.

We shall start the discussion with the late Sargonic texts containing the mu-iti dates and follow it up with the discussion of the texts of the classical Sargonic period.

Eighty-three texts in this volume bear a so-called mu-iti date. The usual form is x mu, x iti, rarely also x mu (AO 11321, 11361, 11366, etc.) and

x iti (AO 11260, 11278, etc.). In texts published elsewhere also the form x mu, x iti, x ud appears, as in the bread and beer texts of MCS IX 234, 235, 241, etc., and in other groups of texts in Dok. II.

Certain groups of texts use the mu-iti dates more frequently than the others. Thus of the eighty-three texts in this volume, fifty-nine deal with animals and skins, and twenty-one with grain, mainly threshed barley, while only three texts (AO 11363, 11373, 11403) deal with extraneous matters.

The highest number of the year recorded in the mu-iti dates known to me from published and unpublished texts, is twenty-five (AO 11272, 11283, 11345, 11365), but there are other texts from the years twenty-three, twenty-two, and twenty-one.

No text with a mu-iti date known to me has a reference to any Sargonic king or a Gutian ruler, even though Gutiens are mentioned in the bread and beer texts bearing a mu-iti date, as in Frank, SKT 43 rev., MCS IX 234 rev., and Dr. Serota A 14 rev.

Against scholars who date the mu-iti texts to the Pre-Sargonic or classical Sargonic periods, for years I have argued in favor of the late Sargonic or Gutian date of those texts. In MAD II<sup>1</sup> p. 16 = MAD II<sup>2</sup> p. 11 my arguments were based on epigraphic considerations and on the references to Gutiens in the mu-iti texts. However, in a supplementary note in MAD II<sup>2</sup> p. 208 I stated that the late Sargonic date "seems confirmed by the occurrence of a PN d<sup>2</sup>Na-ra-am-d<sup>2</sup>EN.Z[U-i-li?] on an unpublished tablet

bearing the date 2 MU 5 ITI 9 UD in the possession of Dr. Serota of Chicago. The name in question cannot be simply Naram-Sin since the tablet deals with administrative matters concerning private individuals. The name is composed of a royal name, here deified, plus an unknown predicate." My suggested reconstruction has been splendidly confirmed by the occurrence of a clear <sup>d</sup>Na-ra-am-<sup>d</sup>EN.ZU-i-li in line 13 of a mu-iti text published recently by Donald, MCS IX 235.

It is obvious that the existence of texts with mu-iti dates having no reference to Sargonic or Gutian rulers points to a time in the late Sargonic period during which the control of the central government either was very weak or ceased altogether in the area which gave rise to the mu-iti system of dating. The question as to whether the number attached to mu "year" represents the year of an era counted from some important event or the year of the tenure of the office of a local ruler, ensi, or even sanga, must be left open for the present.

To the same date as the mu-iti texts must be assigned all the texts not having a mu-iti date, but related to the mu-iti texts by prosopography, epigraphy, and other considerations.

Thus the mu-iti texts which mention Ama-e (wife of Ur-<sup>d</sup>Sara), such as AO 11367 and 11373, are clearly related to several undated texts referring to the activities of that woman, such as AO 11255, 11259, 11280, 11304, 11307, 11312, and 11388. The text AO

11312 in turn mentions Ur-d Nin-d NAGAR.GID sipa, who is obviously the same as Ur-d Nin-d NAGAR.GID udul of the mu-iti texts AO 11277 and 11281. Similar connections can be established among the texts employing the measure gur-sag-gal-dul/kug; see under Writing. All these connections, based on the occurrence of identical personal names, paternity, professions, and measures, are strengthened by considerations of identical types of texts (deposition of commodities, accounts of cattle, of sheepskins, etc.) with and without the mu-iti date.

Especially important for the late Sargonic date of the mu-iti and related texts is AO 11307, a deposition text with reference to Ama-e, which contains in place of the mu-iti date, a date reading u(d)-ba En-an-na-DU en<sub>5</sub>-si Umma<sup>KI</sup> "at the time of Enanatum, ensi of Umma." This type of dating is characteristic of the late Sargonic period.

The Umma provenience of the mu-iti and related texts is based on several considerations. Umma and Zabala(m) are two of the most commonly occurring geographic names in these texts. Zabala(m) (written regularly AB.INNIN<sup>KI</sup>) is localized at modern Ibzaib, about six miles north of Umma; for the reading Zabala(m) cf. the spelling AB.INNIN<sup>KI</sup>-la in Dok. II 49 rev., a mu-iti text. Several epigraphic features of the Umma texts are taken up below under Writing, the most important of these being the form of the fractions for 1/2 and 1/4.

While little doubt remains about the Umma pro-

venience of the late Sargonic texts with the mu-iti date and of all the related texts, the question of the provenience of the classical Sargonic texts in this volume and of the related texts elsewhere remains in doubt.

The first question to be posed is whether the one hundred and fifty-seven texts published in this volume, two of which (AO 11130 and 11131) represent the Acquisition David, Dec. 22, 1927 and the rest (AO 11254-11413) the Acquisition Genouillac, June 22, 1929 in the Louvre catalogues, come from the same site or not. If they do, then there is no problem. Since the late Sargonic texts in this collection come from Umma, the texts of the classical Sargonic period should also be assigned to Umma.

For many years I have taken for granted the Umma derivation of all the one hundred and fifty-seven texts of the Louvre Collection. Now I am not so sure. First of all, it should be noted that the text AO 11254 of the Acquisition Genouillac, June 22, 1929, is written in Akkadian, not in Sumerian as all other texts of that collection in this volume are. Consequently, we must assume that at least the text AO 11254 does not come from Umma. Further, there are unmistakable parallels between some texts in our collection and a group of texts in BIN VIII which Stephens in BIN VIII p. 7 and Sollberger in BO p. 115a assigned to Nippur. In my judgment, the evidence linking this group of BIN VIII texts with Nippur needs detailed corroboration.

The political-historical information which can be gathered from our texts and parallels is presented in the chart on p. xiii. The information concerning Nammah, ensi of Nippur, of AS 17 No. 5, discussed op. cit. pp. 5f. and copied on p. 21, is not listed in that chart, since epigraphically this text comes from the Pre-Sargonic or early Sargonic period. There are several problems in the chart. Is Nammah, who is listed four times, one and the same person? Was he governor at Nippur and also at Umma? Is Nammah the same person as Nammahni, ensi of Umma at the time of the Gutian king Jarlagan? What is the location of IN<sup>KI</sup> in relation to Nippur or Umma?

These problems affect the provenience of a relatively small number of texts in our collection of one hundred and fifty-seven texts. Since the eighty-three mu-iti texts and about forty related texts come from Umma, the uncertainty about the provenience affects only about thirty texts, including the important group of nineteen witnessed contracts.

#### Tablets

With the exception of AO 11413, which is a perforated clay cone, all texts are written on clay tablets. All texts are written in single columns with the exception of four two-column texts, namely AO 11254, 11315, 11391, and 11392. I have had some difficulties in establishing the color of the tablets, especially those described as buff, light buff, or gray.

Writing

Several epigraphic peculiarities of the texts published in this volume can be noted.

Contrary to the general rule of cuneiform writing with respect to word division, words which are normally written in one line are often separated, as in the following cases: 18) PN sipa- 19) da  
i-da-sig, (AO 11267, and similarly in 11297:9f., 11315 rev. i 2f., and 11339:7f.); bar<sup>6)</sup> zú-si-  
ka-ta (AO 11372); and 3) a-sà 4) Am-ma- ta mu-<sup>DU</sup> DU  
(AO 11376).

Certain forms of signs are standardized in our texts, such as  for iti (AO 11350, 11378, 11383, etc.),  for sus (AO 11262, etc.), and  for ug (AO 11257, etc.). The form mu-<sup>DU</sup> occurs in mu-<sup>DU</sup> (AO 11271:3, 11376:4) and in Da-pi-<sup>DU</sup> (AO 11391:9), against the standard mu-DU.DU (AO 11396:15, etc.); cf. also the writing of lú over dingir in ud lú dingir -ma du-da-a in AO 11392 ii 4, which is understandable to me. The form  for pi, occurring three times in AO 11131, is found also in BIN VIII 174:5, 293 i 1<sup>o</sup>, iii 21, and NBC 10202. The form SAL.SI.ĀŠ.GĀR occurs six times in AO 11261:6, 11262:8, 11279:5, 12, and 11315 i 5, ii 2, as against the standard SAL.ĀŠ.GĀR in other texts here and elsewhere. The form U.EDIN for bahar<sup>x</sup> "potter" is found twice in our texts in AO 11274:14 and 11387:9, as it is frequently elsewhere, against the simple EDIN in AO 11343:7. The sign  following gemé in AO 11271:9

is new to me completely. For parallels to the writing túg ti in AO 11303:3 in place of the expected túg bal in AO 11308:3 and elsewhere, see MAD V pp. xxiiif. The question of the sign form GUD plus a vertical (or oblique) wedge in E-gud of AO 11257:13 will be taken up, with many other parallels, in the third edition of MAD II. The sign EŠ in the geographic name Na-EŠ-dù-a (see Index, also in ITT III/2 p. 50, 5852 and Ist. Mus. Lagash 30221) may have the syllabic value as, as shown by Na-áš-dù-a<sup>KI</sup> (ITT II/1 3704).

"Wrong" order of signs is attested in the following cases: Ezen-DUMU.ZI.AN.KA (AO 11321:6) for Ezen-d<sup>d</sup>umu-zi-ka; l lá igi-4-KUG.GÁL.GÍN (AO 11363:1) for l lá igi-4-gál kug gín; 186.2.0 GÁL.ŠE. GUR.SAG (AO 11375:1) for 186.2.0 še gur-sag-gál; and UD.HU.MI.AN.IM (AO 11392 rev. i 3) for d<sup>d</sup>Utu-IM.MI<sup>mušen</sup>. In a text from Tell Asmar? we find the sequence DU+UD.A (AO 8641:6) for UD.DU.A = È.A.

The dry measure of capacity gur-sag-gál-dúl is known to me only from the Umma texts, such as AO 11260, 11278, 11282, 11287, 11296, 11305, 11311?, 11329, 11343, 11360, 11381, 11384, Iraq Mus. 13381, and MCS IX 236 and 238; the measure gur-sag-gál-kug (AO 11273) is unattested elsewhere. Almost all these texts have a mu-iti date.

In the first line of the text lá-ni with the following numbers takes an unusual form in the sheep texts, with the signs lá-ni forming an umbrella over the round numbers. See AO 11272, 11291, 11297, and 11385.

The texts generally use round, not pointed, forms of numbers. But it is interesting to note that several mu-iti texts of the late Sargonic period use exclusively pointed numbers, just as the texts of the following Ur III period. Cf. AO 11301, 11318, 11321, 11324, 11330, 11331, 11348, 11372, 11377, 11380, 11386, and 11387. The vertical pointed numbers are often slightly slanted to the left. Pointed numbers are used regularly in the mu-iti dates, and in years denoting the age of animals, (as in AO 11266:2, 4, 11277:2, 3, 4, 8, 11281:2-6, and 11299:1, 4). Occasionally texts which use generally round numbers also have pointed numbers. Cf. with la-ni in AO 11265:5, 11272:14 and 15, 11314:9, 11385:8; with zag-nu-šus in AO 11396:4; with su-nigin in AO 11255:18; with ma-na in AO 11255:18 (in contrast to a rounded form of l gu); with gin in AO 11392:9; with tug in AO 11406:1-4; with sum in AO 11370:1, 2; with guruš in AO 11410 passim; with gán in AO 11394 passim; and with kus in AO 11332:8 (in contrast to a rounded form in line 1).

A number of texts in this collection have two signs in the form of  $\frac{1}{2}$  and  $\frac{1}{4}$ , which I should like to interpret (provisionally) as fractions for 1/2 and 1/4, respectively. Both forms occur as subdivisions of the dry measure gur in AO 11264, 11270, 11311, 11313, and 11381 (a mu-iti text). The first form only occurs as a subdivision of the measure of length gar-du in AO 11405 and 11409, with the latter text using the form also for a fraction of the measure of

area iku. Cf. also the forms in the difficult text AO 11369, which may be a school exercise.

Outside of our collection, these two forms of fractions occur apparently only in texts from Umma. The second form occurs as a subdivision of gur in Bab. VIII Pl. VIII, Pupil 32, and in several unpublished texts in the Ashmolean Museum, all of Ur III date. The first form is found frequently as a subdivision of the measure of area iku in BIN VIII 82, 86, and 90 of the time of Lugalzagesi, of the liquid measure sila in the Sargonic text BIN VIII 329, and of the measure of weight ma-na in an unpublished Sargonic text Iraq Mus. 5592/8.

#### Language

The first thirteen texts in this volume, which originated either in the Diyala River area or are of unknown origin, are all written either in Akkadian or in noncommittal logograms (AO 8642 and 10330) which can be read in Akkadian. All the other texts in this volume are written in Sumerian. The text AO 1125<sup>4</sup>, which represents the first text in the Acquisition Genouillac, June 22, 1929 collection, is written in Akkadian, and its contents and prosopography show no relation to the other texts in the collection. This text therefore must have originated in an area other than the Sumerian texts in the collection.

#### Contents

Many texts in this volume can be grouped by contents. The largest group of texts deals with

animals, which are mainly sheep and goats, but also bovines. Many texts deal with grain, especially threshed barley. Nineteen witnessed contracts make up a very important group of legal texts.

Omitting from consideration insignificant variants, such as udu-u<sub>8</sub>-ama for u<sub>8</sub>-ama, these are the terms used for sheep and goats in our texts:

The following is a list of the witnessed contracts in this volume: AO 8638, 11130, 11131, 11265, 11274, 11290, 11307, 11309, 11316, 11317, 11319, 11320, 11389, 11390, 11391, 11392, 11395, 11398, and 11412. All these texts may or may not represent one single archive coming from one site, with the exception of AO 8638, which originated in the Diyala River area. These nineteen texts deal with the purchase of individuals, fields, and different commodities. In addition, we find two other witnessed texts, AO 11363 and 11413, which do not deal with acquisitions. The contracts published in this volume show certain relationships with the contracts published in BIN VIII and treated by M. Lambert in RA LIX (1965) pp. 61-72 and 115-126.


