


## Days of the Month



N.B.: The following writings of numerals in dates are restricted to writings whose forms differ in some significant way from those presented in EG 707-12 & of which the reading is at least reasonably certain. Entries with the notation "in sequential list" are part of a sequence of at least one other consecutive date.

N.B.: Many scribes wrote only one sign which can be interpreted as the end of the writing of the name of the month or as the separate word *sw* "day"; unless there was a compelling reason to read the word *sw* "day" separately, this sign was identified as the end of the writing of the name of the month and was included in "Months." In such cases, the writing is included in "Days of the Month" under the heading (*sw*) (+) number. Readers should check originals in any case where they think that there is a passage where we have misdivided the date formula. For examples of writings which have been interpreted as writings of a group "season name + *sw* 'day'," see variants in EG and the entries for the names of the seasons (*šḥ.t*, *pr.t*, *šmw*).
